Youth Empowerment Program (YEP)

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

What is the Youth Empowerment Program?

YEP is an exciting holistic skills development after school program for High School students between grades 9-12 from both private and public schools. The Youth Empowerment Program vision is to inspire young people to compete on the world stage. The Program empowers young people by exposing them to the intricacies and complexities of real life situations. This is done by full exposure and training in - Business skills, College Preparatory skills, Life skills, Entrepreneurship skills, Job Readiness skills, Fine Arts and Drama, Health and Fitness Programs, Business Case Studies, Etiquette and Grooming Programs, Peer Mentorship, Volunteerism, Adult Mentorship, Community service, Conflict Resolution Skills, Civics & Culture, Local and International Field trips, Financial Literacy skills and Spiritual Awareness.

How does it work?

YEP operates for 30 weeks. The program runs parallel to the High School calendar (October –May). A Collection of students from various High Schools make up a group. Groups will meet once per week for approximately (2) two hours normally between 5pm – 8pm. Students will form their unit and will select a group name and elect group Officers in a democratic process. Each group will have a President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Public Relations Director, Sergeant at Arms and Chaplin.

The Program is operated out of districts North, Northwest, South, East, West, South West and Central New Providence. Students will meet at District Centers that have been approved by the YEP Administration Office. Normally Centers will be Schools, Church Community Centers, Civic Groups Centers, and Business Houses Cafeteria. Centers are managed by trained District Managers who will manage the day to day operations.



Volunteers are recruited, trained and vetted and subsequently trained as Mentors for the students. Volunteers are normally recruited from the Community, Cooperate Bahamas, Among School Teachers and Civic Groups. Each group will be assigned no less than (5) five adult mentors to work with the students. Each mentor will be assigned (8-12) students to mentor throughout the Program year.

Students will participate in a variety of formal and informal training exercises, workshops, activities and evaluations to prepare them to successfully compete on the world stage. After successfully completing a year, students will be recognized for their hard work at the annual YEP Awards Presentation.

How do I join?

If you are ready to be empowered to perform on the world stage and to enhance yourself in an exciting and fun way through an excellent program with a proven track record of superior service and delivery. Complete and return an application form to your High School Guidance Counselor or YEP Coordinator. There is **NO** required GPA to join the Youth Empowerment Program, The Program will work with each individual student and meet them at their educational level and will seek additional help for students when necessary. YEP is an extension to your high School learning experience. We just require that you have an open mind and come prepared to have fun and an experience what no other program can offer. YEP only accepts (1,000) one thousand participants each year. Participants are accepted on a first come basis. Completed applications can be submitted to the YEP Head Office.
